In theory, one place is as good as another to build a boat.

In actual practice, Cobalt boats are built in Neodesha, Kansas. The Osage word "Neodesha" (nee-o-da-shay) means "meeting of the waters." In Neodesha's case, the waters would be the Fall and the Verdigris Rivers, and the general obscurity of these geographical names would suggest that Neodesha, Kansas is not Newport, Rhode Island or Newport Beach, California. Nonetheless, from landlocked Kansas, the stereotyped heartland of wheatfields and wind, Cobalt sends out into the world the most prestigious, most carefully crafted boats ever built in their respective classes.

It does not happen by accident.

WELCOME TO

JEODESHA

In 1971, Cobalt founder Pack St. Clair purposely brought his fledgling boat-building enterprise home to southeast Kansas, to a small town place where people know each others' kids by first name, a place where the words "work" and "ethics" slide naturally and easily next to each other. From the outset Pack understood that places don't build boats. People do.

"Family" is a word subject to overuse. Nonetheless, there is in the Cobalt plant in Neodesha a palpable sense of family among people who have worked together for so long, who have known each other since grade school. Cobalt is all about

family too in the most literal sense of the word. The employee roster repeats last names with consistent regularity. Two and three generations of families are employed here, parents and siblings and cousins and nieces and nephews.

Over the years Cobalt has grown in direct proportion to the contributions of these skilled craftspeople who every business day buy again into Cobalt's refusal to compromise. In the ten thousand critical little steps by

which a boat is built, the people of Cobalt demonstrate how conscientious individual effort accumulates to greatness.

Turn the pages that follow. Meet some of the small-town people who, thirty years later, serve Cobalt customers with pride and purpose, who reward day after day two boatbuilders' faith in their remarkable attitudes and abilities. Who, if you were to meet them on the Main Street of Neodesha, Kansas, would greet you with a smile.





It is, however, a long and painstaking and altogether relentless exercise in getting the little things right, and so the Cobalt hand-laid hull begins and ends with people like Chris Willard and his team. Small-town guys who, in Chris' opinion, are "just as skilled, just as conscientious as I am."

At Cobalt we call our multifaceted approach to total fiberglass construction the *Hydrolam* process. Hydrolam calls for the application of a *Kevlar*"/*E-glass* hybrid over the entire length of the keel and chines during hull lamination. Kevlar brings high strength at very light weight,

thermal stability, and ten times the impact resistance of E-glass alone. Kevlar dampens vibration and combines with E-glass fibers to yield a knit material of matchless strength.


At Cobalt fiberglass stringer systems and a fiberglass cockpit sole replace wooden

components — less weight, no sacrifice of structural strength, and a lifetime of rot-free dependability. Hydrolam calls for a liner deck — one-piece construction of deck surfaces, interior side walls, and the floor. The floor is reinforced with *Nida-Core*", a synthetic honeycomb material structurally superior to plywood or balsa.

The Hydrolam process involves *gelcoat graphics* in the production of perfect, permanent images. No add-on tape graphics around here. At Cobalt the graphics begin with a mask in the mold.

White goes on, masks come off, gelcoat colors go on, and the boat's graphics emerge integral to the gelcoat finish.


Finally, a *barrier coat* protects against water vapor that might penetrate the fiberglass and cause blistering. This extra layer of protection caps the best blister-

Recognized throughout the plant in Neodesha as two of the best builders ever to work here, Joyce and Tim put their own standards of accountability on every Cobalt they touch. At day's end they can look out at boats that bear their personal stamp of what's right, and they know what they have done.

Step here to a helm station they're completing.

Ergonomic and functional. Engineered with typical

Cobalt efficiency. Here are helm-based *circuit breakers* and

aircraft-style stainless-steel switches, reliable 20-year switches that
just don't break. And custom, dual-ground wiring harnesses with no
crimp fittings, no butt splices. The overwhelming majority of electrical
problems on boats originate with the grounding, and so Cobalt grounds at the dash and
again in the engine compartment. Here are documented color-coding and no-shortcut

design for trouble-free boating. And quick disconnects should service ever be necessary.

J and T have approved their work on the perfect stitchery of the dash cowl, the easy reading of the screen printing on the *all-aluminum*, *color-matched panels*. They have fingered, critically, the leather tilt steering wheel. They have installed the *rosewood inlays*, polished to a gloss where one, without looking, can see the other.

Day in, day out, they bring something like perfection to designs that leave nothing to chance. Designs that find elegance in simplicity.

That lead to a real nice marriage of form and function.

Her upholstery-subassembly group has more to say about the yearto-year pleasure that Cobalt owners take in their boating than perhaps any other area of construction. Her team's efforts touch Cobalt customers, intimately and unforgettably, on the boat's every use. They touch those

customers between the shoulder blades, in the small of the back, on the backs of thighs.

Dri-Fast Foam makes the difference. It's an open-cell foam that allows water to drain immediately. Cobalt Dri-Fast cushions use high-density specialty polymers to deliver maximum comfort while maintaining superior properties of drainage and durability. What's more, Dri-Fast cushions resist mildew and odor, thanks to a bacteriostat additive.

Obvious care and attention to personal standards of craftsmanship lie everywhere in a Cobalt interior.

In careful finishes of out-of-sight storage areas. In special polyester threads used in all Cobalt upholstery to resist soiling. In *Sony sound systems*. In the selection and use of cabin leathers and heavy vinyls and *rubber-backed 40-ounce carpets*

*Walk-thru doors* — standard equipment on Cobalts, optional equipment on other boats — bring an extra measure of convenience that experienced boaters demand. Big. Solid. Acrylic. These doors lock in place for cockpit warmth on early spring mornings.

The details of being 100% right gather and accumulate. The fit and finish of a masterpiece come together. Seams align. The eyebrow curve of a dash arc in perfect symmetry. And, in her 15 years at Cobalt, Paula Buster has never lost a paycheck.





# "Our approach to research and development at Cobalt has always been to get our hands dirty, to work till we have it right."

For 30 years we have built boats by trying to do every little thing just right. From earliest prototypes through service after the sale, Cobalt deals in simple integrity, in a refusal to ever cut a corner.

Fundamental principles of boat design apply. Without exception. Without compromise.

For example, a deep-V hull rides on a true extended running surface for enhanced bite,

minimal bow rise, quicker planing, and firm, true turns. Cobalt design puts more of the hull's surface in

effective contact with the water at critical times in the boat's performance.

Cobalt introduced the extended running surface years ago, and the imitators have come in the meantime.

And doesn't it make good sense to pay particular attention to the details of construction at known points of stress and wear? On every Cobalt a *bow scuff plate* guards the gelcoat during trailering. Every Cobalt windshield earns strong *stainless steel supports* and, at every point on the boat

where hardware attaches, *aluminum backing plates* embedded in the fiberglass add a lifetime of strength. A *stainless steel rubrail* protects the hull from abrasion dockside. And in an especially


vulnerable spot — the engine vents — Cobalt insists on *solid aluminum vents* finished with powder-coat paint color-matched to the boat. No plastic in sight.

In a small shop at the eastern end of the production area in Neodesha, hand-picked craftsmen are building Cobalts that still exist

only on paper. They work from artwork. From Peter Gramata's [world-class designer Peter Gramata's] conceptual visions of what a boat might yet be. Amid the build-up and the hand-sanding of the first of these visions, Cobalt is engineering the next generation of boat-building in America. Be assured that traditional values of strength and long-term performance will be carefully fabricated into these ever-newer, ever-better Cobalts.

Proof?

Again this evening, Roger Jones will go home dirty.

Envy Rick Shadduck.

He has the authority to walk into the final-assembly area, point to a Cobalt, and say, "I want that one." Whereupon, Rick trailers the boat to the lake and completes a two-hour shakedown cruise. Rick Shadduck tests Cobalt boats in actual, first-time use.

Rick has more fun than most jobs allow, and he has good help too, in other determinations of Cobalt quality.

Test tank: no Cobalt leaves the factory without the rigorous scrutiny imposed by the 30/30 test program, a stem-to-stern examination of 30 critical systems. During a half-hour in the water. Under power, under power with a load. With particular emphasis on the engine, outdrive, and electrical systems.

Statistical analysis of raw materials: testing to specification to ensure that gelcoats, barriers coats, resin, glass, adhesives, and core materials meet Cobalt demands for quality and consistency.

Instron tensile tester: a next-generation tool of the aerospace and automotive industries, it measures the ultimate strength, yield strength, elongation, and stiffness of Cobalt laminates.

Statistical Process Control: this time-honored, proven QA methodology monitors glass-to-resin ratio, catalyst and cure time, the atomization pressure of spray and lamination

equipment, resin temperatures, and conditions throughout the plant for temperature and humidity to guarantee that the strength of Cobalt fiberglass and the glory of Cobalt finishes remain the industry's standard.

Ultrasonic testing: this nit-picking electronic test measures hull thickness, scrutinizing every Cobalt hull at 24 strategic locations on the running surface and dozens more test sites on the deck and hull sides. At Cobalt, we know that few standards of construction matter more than uniform fiberglass thickness.

And finally, Rick's random selection: His "I'll take this one to the lake" testing under actual operational conditions keeps everyone focused on the absolute importance of making every boat right.

A quick review of Cobalt quality-assurance technology — test tanks, ultrasonic examination, statistical process control, Instron tensile investigation, Rick Shadduck and 400 or so of his friends back in town.

An aft wrap-around lounge cradles seven passengers. The galley, designed in a flowing curve, is both elegant and functional. Hidden within the passenger-side console, the head





For all its luxury, all its entertainment value, the 293 is still very practical.

Storage is everywhere. Under every seat. In the cedar-lined hanging locker, in the transom fender locker, in the insulated cockpit ice chest. An electric windlass lifts the anchor into stowage. Engineered below the contour of the foredeck, it does nothing to break the smooth flow of the 293's profile, which bears the sleek protection of stainless steel, as do the boat's most vulnerable parts, from the bow and anchor scuff plates to the transom ladder. The 293's electrical system approximates a small apartment's, supplying power through an AC/DC distribution panel to a water heater with exchanger, an air

compressor, and the various appliances. A complete battery recharging system is available; a fourkilowatt generator is optional, for full liveaboard capability.

An added layer of Prefixx® wards off stains and protects from the sun's damaging ultraviolet rays. Carpets are just as luxurious - 40 ounces plush, snap-out, and rubber backed.

### XTERIOR COLORS

All graphics are part of Cobalt's superior gelcoat finish, not added to the surface. These permanent colors being gelcoat are warranted for two years from crazing, stress cracks and blisters.
